

KAIĀULU HO'OKIPA PROGRAM

The Native Hawaiian Hospitality Association (NaHHA) and travel2change are partnering to help Hawaii non-profit organizations and community groups build capacity to host experiences for kama'āina and visitors in a manner that advances the community's vision and aspirations, a key concept of regenerative tourism.

The partnership will recruit interested groups for a pilot cohort that will commence in October. The program will include sessions to develop their organizational capacity, experience NaHHA's signature Hawaiian cultural training, develop their activity experience offering, and list their activity on travel2change's platform. Cohort members will meet with existing travel2change activity hosts, organizational development experts, NaHHA's team of trainers and practitioners, and other professionals tailored for the cohort's success.

HOW TO APPLY

Listed on www.travel2change.org/apply are the basic minimum requirements to apply for the 2021 Kaiāulu Hoʻokipa Cohort program and a set of questions that will explore the nexus between your organization and the mission of our program. Please fill out the online application by Friday, October 15, 2021 at 4:00pm (HST). Upon submission of the online application, you will receive a confirmation email from info@travel2change.org

A virtual interview will be scheduled. Applicants that are chosen to participate in the Kaiāulu Hoʻokipa Cohort will be notified via email. Cohort members will receive over 40 hours of business development, experience building, cultural training, etc.
